INTRODUCTION:

After the session, students were acquainted with basic knowledge of temple architecture and different vision for career options which they can opt for themselves after graduation.

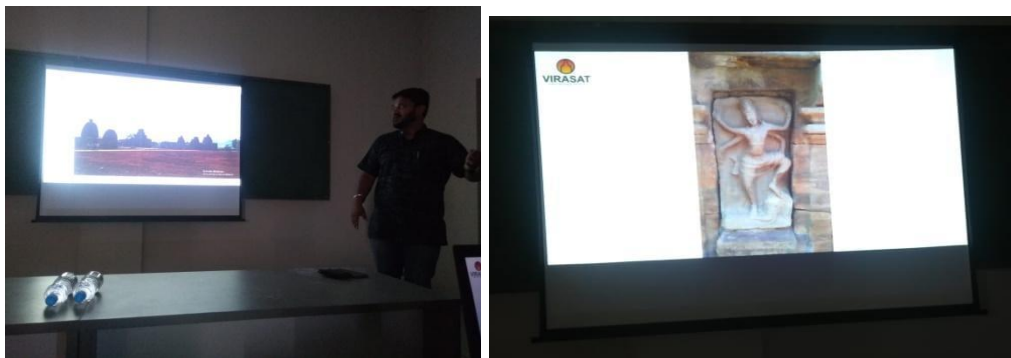


Figure 1 – Mr. Indraneel Bankapure explaining about the temple architecture.
