

WORKSHOP ON 'INDOOR & OUTDOOR SKETCHING'

Sanjay Ghodawat University, School of Architecture, Atigre conducted a one-day workshop on 'INDOOR & OUTDOOR SKETCHING', on 15/03/2021. The workshop was conducted for First Year B. Arch students by Ar. Sharadchandra Moghe.

The workshop commenced by a brief introduction of the guest Ar. Sharadchandra Moghe.

AIM: The workshop was conducted to learn the Basic Sketching skills & proportion understanding in architecture.

OBJECTIVES: From the given exercises students should learn Basic proportion calculation of the object & draw indoor/outdoor sketches without hurdle.

The topics covered in the one-day sketching workshop are as follows:

- 1) Basic introduction to sketching- from small solid objects to buildings, trees & outdoor furniture.
- 2) Understanding Composition & Correlation of objects, Shades & Shadows.

The students learnt the Basic sketching techniques. The assignment was given to draw 5 sketches of small objects along with shades & shadows and an outdoor sketch.
