



CHEMISTRY QUIZ RULES

GENERAL RULES:

1. Individual or team entries are eligible for quiz competition.
2. A team shall consist of max three persons.
3. Elimination Round is mandatory for all team members.
4. The elimination round is based on 25 multiple choice questions (subject related) with time limit of 30 minutes.
1. In the elimination exam the correct answer will carry 2 Marks.No negative marking for wrong answer.
5. The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
6. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile, other electronic instruments or any resources.
7. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific-answer question etc.
8. Audience shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
9. Replacement of any participant of a team is not entertained after registration.
10. The final quiz rules will be declare on the spot.

ELIMINATION ROUND

- Questions will be asked on the basic Chemistry, general knowledge and recent research and development related to Chemistry.
- The question difficulty level will be of elementary and graduate level.
- Each team member would be given a set of question paper containing 25 multiple choice objective type questions
- Time limit - 30 minutes
- Only first 5 Teams would be selected for STAGE ROUNDS



- In case of tie between 2 or more teams, for the fifth position, further 5 questions would be asked for final selection.
- The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round.
- Teams selected for the final quiz rounds will be allowed to give themselves an appropriate name related to the competition by which they may want to be known.

FINAL QUIZ

Round 1, 2 and 3 are based on the basic Chemistry, general knowledge and recent research and development related to Chemistry. The question difficulty level will be of elementary and graduate level.

STAGE ROUNDS

1. Objective question round

Round 1: Each team would be asked 5 questions each. (Objective questions with options)

- 10 marks for correct answer and 5 negative marks for wrong answer.
- Answering time is only 45 seconds.
- Team discussion is allowed.

2. Rapid Fire Round

Round 2: Each team will be asked 5 questions one after another in 50 seconds time.

- 10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong answer
- Team discussion is allowed
- If a team cannot answer the question, they can say pass for the next question.
- Only one pass is allowed for a team.
- The question will **not** be forwarded to the next team.

3. Buzzer Round

Established as a State Private University under Govt. of Maharashtra Act no. XL dated 3rd May 2017

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Round 3: A question will be fired & the team who presses the buzzer first gets to answer first. Total 10 questions will be asked in this round.

- 10 mark for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong or if team doesn't answer after pressing the Buzzer.
- No forwarding
- Answering time is only 60 second.

4. Visual round

Round 4: Teams will be shown an image and will have to identify the personality in the image (rounds 2): **5 visuals.**

- This is also a buzzer round.
- 10 mark for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong or if team doesn't answer after pressing the Buzzer.
- Answering time is only 30 seconds.

5. Tie breaker round (If required)

Round 5: Tie up round is audio/visual round
